

Workshop/Activity Leader

As a workshop/activity leader you will be responsible for running an interactive Workshop (30 minutes) or Activity Station (15 minutes) throughout the day to groups of 15 - 30 students (approximate ages of 10 - 12 years old). At your station you will teach fundamental concepts related to energy and climate change plus answer students questions about activity lessons and concepts. Some examples of past favourites include "Waste Reduction Relay Race," "Making Ice Cream" and "Building a Straw Bale House".

Responsibilities:

- ✓ Before the festival read your activity centre description and fully understand the purpose and concept of your activity.
- ✓ Staff and manage your assigned activity during school visits.
- ✓ Ensure active participation from all students!

Associated Skills:

- ✓ Basic knowledge of climate change, sustainable energy issues and/or energy science is an asset. You will be responsible for explaining concepts in a fun and easy to understand manner.
